## EMERGENCY TOXIC MATERIAL PERMIT

Pursuant to the provision of Title 9 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland and water pollution control regulation 26.08.03.02.C (3), the Department of the Environment hereby authorizes use of toxic materials for aquatic life management purposes.

The approval and authorization to use toxic materials for aquatic life management purposes is given subject to the following conditions:

1. The toxic material approved for use is restricted to \_\_\_\_\_
